Lucile was born Dec. 28, 1927, in Megargel to the late Henry F. and Clara Olsen Harmel. She married Robert "Bob" Andrews Jan. 11, 1951, in Wichita Falls. She graduated from Megargel High School and the University of Texas with a Bachelor of Science degree in home economics. She was an upper class advisor, Orange Jacket, Theta Sigma Phi journalist, Good Fellow vice president of Presbyterian Fellowship, home economics college club president and president of the national home economics association. She served as a trustee and board member of Southwest Radio Church in Oklahoma City for 30 years and was a member of the Republican Women, Desk & Derrick in Wichita Falls, and Texas Cattlewomen's Association.
